ELECTRICITY RETAILER BUYBACK RATES

The rates listed below are correct as of February 2013. The rates are indicative only as they are subject to change at any time. For an up to date price list please contact your power supplier.

All rates only apply to generating capacity not exceeding 10kW operated in conjunction with a consumption/load.

Each supplier has their own associated set up costs, application form, and method for buying the power back. We can give you an idea of how each company below structures this, but as always it's best to contact your supplier.

electricity retailer	buy-back rate	our opinion
Meridian	25cents/kWh (+gst) for the first 5kWh, per day then 10cents/kWh (+gst) for any other kWh exported up to a total of 10kWh/day	This is the best offer if you have a smaller system and you export less than 5kWh per day back to the grid.
Contact	17.285cents/kWh (+gst)	Since this is a pretty good price at a flat rate you'd be best to go with Contact if you have a large system, or a low occupancy residence.
Genesis	Varies between 4-7cents/kWh depending on your area. North Island only.	Why would you really compared to Contact's flat rate.
Trust Power	7.0cents/kWh (+gst) up to 10kWh per day	A low rate, but if you are already with Trust Power your TECT cheque will still apply.
Mercury Energy	The same as what you pay them up to the amount you import. Any units brought back over what you import are 3.5cents/kWh (AKLD & CHCH only)	For most people, Mercury's offer will actually pay you the highest rate, but it won't be your best option if you're only importing a small amount from them. Prompt payment discounts still apply.
Nova	7.2cents/kWh	Why would you really compared to Contact's flat rate.
